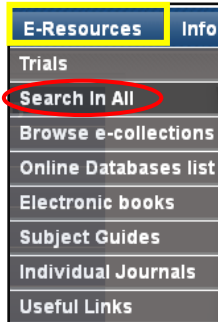


Access EDS

To save more time,
We have subscribed to a new dynamic tool named: *Ebsco Discovery Service (EDS)* which will enable the user to search within our databases and electronic books from one single place in a more efficient and active way.

Very few databases were not included inside this tool such as:
World Development Indicators *WDI*, Africa Development Indicators *ADI* and Global Economic Monitors *GEM* Due to its different nature of search, though you can always search them individually as they will be found opposite to the searching box or under the online databases list under *E-Resources* tab.
