


Emerald: Quick Guide

This helpsheet provides instructions on how to search and find journal articles in the Emerald database. Emerald contains the most comprehensive collection of peer reviewed management journals as well as public policy, society and education journals.


How do I access Emerald?

Via the BUE Library website, E- Resources, Online database link at http://lib.bue.edu.eg/buecms/index.php/Online_Databases#Emerald



Emerald provides 2 methods of searching; either a **Quick Search** with simple keywords or an **Advanced Search** that allows you to focus your search from the beginning.

If you want to search in particular journal for the contents of the latest issue, you can select the title from this drop down menu.



You can also browse specific journals and books or look for journals in a specific subject area by going to **Browse**, then clicking on the **Books & Journals** button.

You can then search by the **title** of a particular journal or by **Subject**.



Using the **Advanced Search** means that you can combine several search terms. Note the use of the * to make sure that we search for *organisation* and *organization*.

You can limit the date of publication by using this feature.

You can also choose which fields to search in from the drop down menu, e.g. *Abstract*, *Title*, *Author*, *All Fields*

By marking the box next to **My Subscribed Content**, you will retrieve results for which you have access to the full text.

Your search results will be displayed as lists of short records. The default setting is to display results by relevance. You can click on the various tabs on the tool bar to look in **journals only**, or **books**, **site pages** etc. You can open full text articles in either **HTML** or **PDF** format, **Preview** the article or view the **Abstract only**.
